## ICE CREAM SOCIAL BRINGS OUT PRODUCERS FOR PROPOSED CCTV RULES & PROCEDURES CHANGES

On Wednesday, April 2 approximately 30 community producers filled the CCTV studio to discuss changes to CCTV's Rules and Procedures with staff.

CCTV's Rules and Procedures were established in 1990 and modified once in 1995. Changes in technology and use created the need for review. CCTV is working to address the needs of the entire community on each of the issues listed, taking into account the needs and rights of speakers and viewers while protecting the resource and community television providers.

- **NUMBER OF PROGRAM PLAYS AND A REVISED PROGRAM CONTRACT**  
–increase from 6 to 10 the number of plays for locally produced individual programs.
- **CCTV WEBCASTING OF PRODUCERS' PROGRAMS**  
–unlike the community channels, CCTV is the publisher of its website and will select programs to stream in a manner similar to its newsletter. Insurance and copyright issues are complex. CCTV will stream only government meetings until all issues are resolved.
- **PRODUCER STREAMING OF PROGRAMS PRODUCED WITH CCTV MANAGED EQUIPMENT**  
–producers may not use complete programs or re-edit material recorded with CCTV equipment for use on a commercial website or to use for solicitation on a non-commercial website.

- **TIME WINDOW FOR POTENTIALLY OBJECTIONABLE/INDECENT PROGRAMS**  
–Under review. CCTV currently uses the FCC window of 10 pm to 6 am. CCTV is developing a list of all legal options.
- **CONTACT INFORMATION DURING PROGRAMS**  
–continue the limit on contact information to sponsor credits and contact information not to exceed one minute per half hour including websites. Websites listed may not be commercial.
- **SUBSEQUENT USE OF PROGRAMS PRODUCED WITH CCTV MANAGED EQUIPMENT**  
–programs are allowed on community channels elsewhere and sales to non-commercial television and individual copies are OK. But no sales to commercial television and no re-editing of material into a commercial project are allowed. The rules lack clarity on proceeds a producer may receive from commercial sales of a program produced with CCTV managed equipment. CCTV is researching "private benefit" regulations. Under review: any sales of programs require 50% of gross to go to CCTV for use in providing the community resource.

## CCTV PROFILES

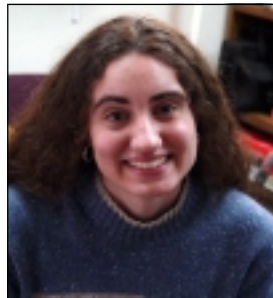
LOYD KUMLEY

# CCTV WORKSHOP INFORMATION

ALL WORKSHOPS REQUIRE ATTENDANCE AT AN ORIENTATION.

Orientation provides you with an introduction to community access television and is required of all interested persons.

ORIENTATIONS ARE ON THE FIRST TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH: JUNE 3, AUG. 5 AT 6 PM IN THE CCTV STUDIO.

## REGISTRATION

Class sign-up and payment of fees are conducted at the free monthly orientations.

## FEES

Workshop fees must be paid **before** the workshops begin.

CAMCORDER – \$15

LINEAR EDITING – \$15

FINAL CUT PRO – \$30

STUDIO WORKSHOP – \$30

A \$35 Annual Activity Fee is added to the **first** class registration.

This fee is paid once a year and stretches limited resources to help CCTV maintain its equipment in good working condition for all community producers.

## ELIGIBILITY

People residing within the city limits of Salem and unincorporated Marion County are eligible for CCTV classes and services.

## CAMCORDER

This class certifies you to operate either an **Elura 2** or a **Sony DSR 200** camcorder.

Learn to use the camcorder for location shooting. **Camera technique, lighting and basic audio recording are all covered in this hands-on interactive class.** Then enter the edit suite and learn how to put your footage together with cuts, effects and titling.

**The Elura** – is a small, extremely lightweight digital camcorder featuring a large screen viewfinder. It is very portable and comes with a lightweight tripod.

**The Sony DSR 200** – is a full size industrial grade digital camcorder featuring complete manual and automatic controls for both audio and video. It's a chunkier camcorder and tripod combination.

## NON-LINEAR EDITING

Non Linear editing is done on a computer. CCTV offers a class in **Final Cut Pro** which is especially suited for projects that have many shots, many cuts and dissolves. **Final Cut Pro** runs on Macintosh G4 computers. **You'll learn to log & capture, basic editing, graphics, output to tape.**
